1. Short Title.	

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to Apply Certain Sums of Money Out of the Public Account and Other Accounts Towards the Service of the Year Ending on the Thirty-first Day of March, Nineteen hundred and fifty-one. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Imprest Supply Act (No. 5), 1950. Short Title.

2. (1) In addition to all sums otherwise granted there may be issued and applied, by way of imprest, towards the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and fifty-one,— Imprest grants.

(a) Out of the respective accounts (being part of the Public Account) mentioned in the First Schedule hereto, any sums not exceeding in respect of any such account the appropriate amount specified in that Schedule, and not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of nineteen million one hundred and three thousand pounds:

(b) Out of the respective accounts mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto, any sums not exceeding in respect of any such account the appropriate amount specified in that Schedule, and not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of one million eight hundred and seventeen thousand pounds. 5

(2) All sums issued and applied under the authority of this section shall be charged in the manner hereafter to be expressed in any Act passed in this present session of Parliament for appropriating the public revenues for the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and fifty-one. 10
