A BILL INTITULED,

AN ACT to apply a Sum of Money out of the Public Account to the Service of Title.
the Year ending the Thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Imprest Supply Act, 1882."

Short Title.

2. Out of the Public Account there may be issued and applied, towards
5 making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty by way of Imprest for the
service of the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight
hundred and eighty-three, in addition to the sums mentioned in the Civil List Act
and other Acts, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole three hundred
thousand pounds, that is to say, two hundred thousand pounds out of the
10 Consolidated Fund, and one hundred thousand out of the Public Works Fund,
to be charged in the manner hereafter to be expressed in any Act or Acts passed
in this present session of Parliament for appropriating the Public Revenues of
the colony for the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight
hundred and eighty-three.
