5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Imprest Supply Act, Short Title. 1886."

2. Out of the Public Account there may be issued and applied, £250,000 advanced 10 towards making good the Supply granted to Her Majesty by way of on Imprest towards Imprest for the service of the year ending the thirty-first day of ending 31st March, March, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven, in addition to the sums mentioned in the Civil List Act and other Acts, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole two hundred and fifty thousand
