A BILL INTITULED

An Act to apply a Sum of Money out of the Public Title. Account and other Accounts to the Service of the Year ending the Thirty-first Day of March,

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

Nineteen hundred and thirty-seven.

1. This Act may be cited as the Imprest Supply Short Title. 10 Act. 1936.

2. In addition to all sums otherwise granted, there Imprest grants. may be issued and applied, by way of imprest, towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirty-first day of 15 March, nineteen hundred and thirty-seven,---

(a) Out of the respective funds and accounts (being part of the Public Account) specified in the First Schedule hereto, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole seven million five hundred and one thousand pounds, as set forth in that Schedule:

(b) Out of the respective accounts mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto, the respective sums therein set forth, not exceeding in the whole one million and four thousand five hundred pounds.

In addition to the amounts specified in the last preceding section the Minister of Finance is Promotion Fund. hereby authorized to pay out of the Consolidated Fund into the Employment Promotion Fund such sums of money as he may from time to time direct, 10 not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of three hundred thousand pounds.

> 4. The aforesaid sums shall be charged in the manner hereafter to be expressed in any Act or Acts passed in this present session of Parliament for appro-15 priating the public revenues of the Dominion for the year ending the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and thirty-seven.
