A BILL INTITULED

An Act to apply a Sum of Money out of the Public Account and Title. other Accounts to the Service of the Year ending the Thirtyfirst Day of March, One thousand nine hundred and seven.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Imprest Supply Act, Short Title 1906 (No. 2)."

10 2. In addition to all sums otherwise granted, there may be Imprest grants. issued and applied, by way of imprest, towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the service of the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and seven,-

(a.) Out of the respective funds and accounts (being part of the Public Account) specified in the First Schedule hereto, any sums of money not exceeding in the whole five hundred and sixty-one thousand pounds, as set forth in that Schedule;

(b.) Out of the respective accounts mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto, the respective sums therein set forth, not exceeding in the whole ten thousand five hundred pounds; and

(c.) Out of the Consolidated Fund, for transfer to the Public Works Fund, any sums not exceeding one hundred thousand pounds.

3. The aforesaid sums shall be charged in the manner hereafter To be charged as to be expressed in any Act or Acts passed in this present session of expressed in future Parliament for appropriating the public reverse of the property of the public reverse o Parliament for appropriating the public revenues of the colony for

30 the year ending the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and seven.
