BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Juries Act 1880 Amend-Short Title. ment Act, 1883."

2. Sections fifty-two to sixty, both inclusive, of "The Juries Abolition of Grand Act, 1880" (hereinafter called "the said Act"), are hereby repealed;

and, notwithstanding any law to the contrary in force in New Zealand,

10 Grand Juries are hereby abolished.
