A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Juries Act, 1880."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Juries Act Amendment Act, 1906"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Juries Act, 1880."

Short Title.

10 2. Section one hundred and fifty-six of "The Juries Act, 1880," is hereby amended by repealing the words "any civil cause," and substituting in lieu thereof the words "any case, whether civil or criminal."
