### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Term of Office of the Chief Justice of New Zealand. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Judicature Amendment Act, 1945, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Judicature Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.
2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirteen of the principal Act, the person holding the office of Chief Justice of New Zealand at the passing of this Act may continue to hold that office for a period not exceeding one year from the sixth day of September, nineteen hundred and forty-five.
