BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Judicature Amend- Short Title. ment Act, 1947, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Judicature Act, 1908 (hereinafter see Reprint of Statutes, Vol. II, p. 60 10 referred to as the principal Act).
