- 1 Title**
This Act is the Judicature Amendment Act (No 2) **2007**.
- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent. 5
- 13 Amendments to Judicature Act 1908**
This subpart amends the Judicature Act 1908.
- 14 Age of retirement**
Section 13 is amended by omitting “68” and substituting “70”. 10
- 15 Rights on retirement before attaining retiring age**
Section 14 is amended by omitting “68” in each place where it appears and substituting in each case “70”.

16 Vacation of office

Section 26E(3) is amended by omitting “68” and substituting “70”.

17 Temporary Associate Judges

Section 26H(3) is amended by omitting “68” and substituting “70”. 5
