JOHNSONVILLE SCHOOL RESERVE ACT AMENDMENT.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Johnsonville School Reserve Act, 1898," and to authorise the Johnsonville Town Board to erect Buildings and provide for General or Technical Education. Title.

5 WHEREAS by a Local Act the Short Title of which is "The Johnsonville School Reserve Act, 1898," the parcel of land described in the Schedule to that Act is vested in the Johnsonville Town Board (hereinafter styled "the Board"), and its successors, for the purpose of a common school at Johnsonville, subject to all laws and regulations relating to such schools in the Provincial District of Wellington, and the Board is thereby authorised to let or demise, or otherwise deal therewith, in manner prescribed by "The Public Bodies' Powers Act, 1887": And whereas the rents and income arising from the said land have accumulated, and it is expedient to authorise the Board to apply such accumulated rents and income, and all other rents and income to arise from such land, in the manner hereinafter provided: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Johnsonville School Reserve Act Amendment Act, 1900." Short Title.

2. The Board may in its discretion apply all accumulated rents and income, and all rents and income henceforth arising from the said land, for all or any of the purposes following, that is to say:— Accumulated rents and income henceforth arising may be applied by Johnsonville Town Board in erecting buildings, and providing for the general and technical education of children resident in the Johnsonville Town District.

(1.) In erecting buildings or other erections on the said land, and in repairing and improving such buildings, erections, and land.

(2.) In or towards the erection of any building to be used for a school, or for educational purposes, situate within the limits for the time being of the Johnsonville Town District,

and in repairing and improving such building and the premises connected therewith.

- (3.) In or towards the support and maintenance of any school or educational institution for the time being existing within the limits for the time being of the said district, for the purpose of affording general or technical education to children resident within such limits as aforesaid. 5
