A BILL INTITULED

An Act to provide for the payment of full adult wages to persons of 20 years of age

WHEREAS the young men and women of New Zealand are
increasingly mature and responsible, and whereas it is proposed that the right to vote, and the right to enter upon licensed premises should shortly be extended to those of 20 years of age, and whereas those employed in industry make an adult contribution to production, it is just that such young 10 men and women should qualify for full adult wages:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Just Wage Act 15 1969.

2. Purpose of Act—The Government is hereby instructed and authorised to amend relevant legislation to give effect to the purposes of this Act.
