A BILL INTITULED

AN Act to vest certain Lands in Kaitangata in the Corporation of the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Kaitangata. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Kaitangata Creek Vesting Act, 1896." Short Title.

10 2. On the passing of this Act the lands described in the Schedule hereto shall vest in the Corporation of the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Kaitangata. Lands to vest in Kaitangata Borough Council.

3. The Council of the said Corporation may arrange for the reclamation of such portions of the said lands as may be deemed necessary. Council may arrange for reclamation.

15 4. The Council may set aside the said lands or any portion or portions thereof for public streets, and may lease or sell any portions thereof not required for public streets. Council may sell or lease portions of land.

20 Her Majesty or to any railway company as may be necessary or desirable for the purpose of laying, maintaining, and retaining control of any railway, railway-siding, or sidings on or over such land. Council may grant for railway purposes.

SCHEDULE.

Schedule.

ALL that area of land in the Provincial Land District of Otago, and Colony of New Zealand, being portion of the Kaitangata Creek, *North Molyneux Survey District*, containing by admeasurement 2 roods and 22 poles, *more or less*. Bounded by a line commencing at a point being the intersection of the north boundary of Elizabeth Street with Water Street, in the Town of Kaitangata, and bounded proceeding thence towards the east by southerly along the said Water Street, 70 links; thence again generally towards the east by along a reserve now vested in the Bruce County, 1000 links; thence towards the south-east by south-westerly along a road reserve and Exmouth Street, 280 530 links; thence towards the west by other part of the said Kaitangata Creek, northerly along the Clutha River, 60 links; thence again generally towards the west by along a road-line fronting part of Section No. 1, Block IV., North Molyneux District, and Elizabeth Street, 1250 1500 links; and finally towards the north by easterly along other part of said Kaitangata Creek, 90 links: be all the aforesaid linkages and area either more or less.
