A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Land Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Land Amendment Act, 1921, and shall be read together with and be deemed part of the Land Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title.

10 2. Section three hundred and nineteen of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "royalty under any license for cutting timber or flax," and substituting the words "the disposal of Crown timber or flax by sale, lease, or license."

Half receipts from timber and flax sales to be paid local authorities.
