A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Licensing Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority  
5 of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Licensing Amendment Act, 1933. Short Title.

2. Subparagraph (i) of paragraph (a) of section one hundred and forty-six and section two hundred and  
10 seventy-three of the Licensing Act, 1908, are hereby amended by adding thereto the following proviso:—  
Principal Act amended.

“ Provided that advertising of liquor in any newspaper (whether published in or out of a no-license area) shall not be deemed to be the soliciting of orders for liquor  
15 within the meaning of this section.”
