A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Powers of Local Authorities in certain Title. Matters during the Continuance of the Present War.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Authorities Empowering Short Title. Act, 1915.

2. For the purposes of this Act "local authority" has the same Interpretation. 10 meaning as in Part XIV of the Public Revenues Act, 1910.

3. A local authority may grant leave of absence to any of its Leave of absence on employees-

(a.) While engaged on military service within New Zealand; authorities engaged

(b.) While engaged as a member of any Expeditionary Force 15on military service beyond New Zealand, and for such period thereafter, not exceeding twelve months, as the local authority thinks fit;

and may, during such leave of absence, pay to every such employee 20 or to his order the whole or any part of the salary or wages of that employee, at the rate at which he was employed at the commencement of such leave of absence.

4. Any local authority possessing rating-powers may remit Provision tor either wholly or in part, or may postpone for such time as it thinks remission of rates payable by members 25 fit the date of payment of, any rates payable by any person who is a of Expeditionary member of any Expeditionary Force intended for or engaged on Forces. military service beyond New Zealand.

Validation of past payments or remissions.

Interpretation.

5. All moneys heretofore paid by any local authority since the commencement of the present war by way of salary or wages to or to the order of any employee engaged on military service within New Zealand or as a member of any Expeditionary Force for military service beyond New Zealand and all remissions of rates 5 made to members of any Expeditionary Force shall be deemed to have been as validly paid and made as if this Act had been in force at the time when such payments or remissions were made.

6. For the purpose of this Act the expression "member of any Expeditionary Force" means an officer, non-commissioned officer, 10 or man in any Expeditionary Force heretofore or hereafter raised for service beyond New Zealand, and includes nurses and other persons engaged or employed in any capacity in connection with any such force.
