A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Operation of the Local Authorities Empowering (Relief of Unemployment) Act, 1926. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Authorities Empowering (Relief of Unemployment) Extension Act, 1929, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Local Authorities Empowering (Relief of Unemployment) Act, 1926. Short Title.

2. Section two of the Local Authorities Empowering (Relief of Unemployment) Amendment Act, 1928, is hereby amended by omitting from subsection one the reference to the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, and substituting a reference to the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and thirty. Extension of period within which local authorities may borrow money in relief of unemployment.
