A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Operation of the Local Authorities Empowering (Relief of Unemployment) Act, 1926. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Authorities Empowering (Relief of Unemployment) Extension Act, 1931, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Local Authorities Empowering (Relief of Unemployment) Act, 1926 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act). Short Title.

2. (1) No moneys shall be borrowed under the authority of the principal Act after the *thirty-first* day of *July*, nineteen hundred and *thirty-two*. Extension of period within which local authorities may borrow money in relief of unemployment. Consequential repeal.

(2) The Local Authorities Empowering (Relief of Unemployment) Extension Act, 1930, is hereby repealed.
