1. Short Title.

Extension of period within which local authorities may borrow money in relief of unemployment. Consequential repeal.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to extend the Operation of the Local Authorities Empowering Title. (Relief of Unemployment) Act, 1926.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Authorities Empowering Short Title. (Relief of Unemployment) Extension Act, 1931, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Local Authorities Empowering 10 (Relief of Unemployment) Act, 1926 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. (1) No moneys shall be borrowed under the authority of the Extension of period principal Act after the thirty-first day of July, nineteen hundred and thirty-two.

15 (2) The Local Authorities Empowering (Relief of Unemployment) Extension Act, 1930, is hereby repealed.
