A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Life Assurance Policies Act 1884  
Amendment Act, 1890." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in  
5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Life Assurance Policies  
Act 1884 Amendment Act, 1890." Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in section  
thirty-three of "The Life Assurance Policies Act, 1884," the moneys  
10 payable under any policy heretofore or hereafter to be issued shall  
become available for the payment of debts under an intestacy and for  
debts due by a testator without being specially directed by the will  
of such testator to be paid; and it is hereby declared that this Act  
15 upon which "The Life Assurance Policies Act, 1884," came into
