A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1886." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Local Bodies' Loans Act Amendment Act, 1900." Short Title.

2. (1.) Section twenty-one of "The Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1886" (hereinafter called "the principal Act"), providing for raising a loan without taking a poll in a district where the number of ratepayers does not exceed one hundred, shall apply to a part of a district where the number of ratepayers in such part does not exceed one hundred. Consent of ratepayers in part of a district.

(2.) The Governor may make regulations for prescribing the form of consent to be signed by ratepayers, and generally for giving effect to the said section.

3. Subsection four of section thirty-seven of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing the words "in full" and substituting in lieu thereof the words "full particulars of," and the Second Schedule to the principal Act shall be read and construed accordingly. Section 37, (4), amended.
