A BILL INTITULED

An Act to alter the Constitution of the Legislative Council of Title. New Zealand.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Preamble. 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Legislative Council Act, Short Title. 1890."

2. From and after the passing of this Act all members appointed Members to be 10 by the Governor to the Legislative Council shall be appointed for ten years and eligible years only: Provided that members so appointed shall, when their for reappointment term of office is completed, or in the event of their resignation before the completion of their term of office, be eligible for reappointment by the Governor.

3. Whenever, after the passing of this Act, a vacancy occurs in Speaker to be the office of Speaker of the Legislative Council the members of the Legislative Council shall proceed to the choice of one of their members to be the Speaker thereof for ten years, and such choice, on being confirmed by the Governor, shall be valid and effectual.
