A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to alter the Term of Appointment of Members of the Legislative Council of New Zealand. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Legislative Council Act, 1912. Short Title.
- 2. Every person who, after the passing of this Act, is duly appointed a member of the Legislative Council of New Zealand shall hold his seat therein for three years, to be reckoned from the date of the instrument of his appointment, and no longer. Members hereafter appointed to hold office for three years.
