### A BILL INTITULED

# An Act to make further Provision for the Final Settle- Title. ment of Land Claims.

THEREAS there yet remain unsettled various claims to land Preamble. within the Colony of New Zealand, arising out of dealings with the aboriginal inhabitants thereof (which claims are enumerated in the Schedule hereto), and it is expedient to make further provision for the 5 final settlement thereof: And whereas sundry Crown grants of doubtful validity have been issued in respect of some of the aforesaid claims under the Public Seal of the Colony of New Zealand, prior to the passing of the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six: And whereas all such Crown grants were called in under the provisions of the Act 10 of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six in order that new grants might be issued in lieu thereof: And whereas in some cases no claim for the issue of a new grant has been made, and in other cases, although a claim for a new grant has been made, the claim has not been prosecuted to a final issue: And whereas it is not expedient that 15 any such claims should be allowed to remain open for an indefinite period:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Land Claims Final Short Title. 20 Settlement Act, 1878."

2. The terms "Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six," Interpretation clause. and "Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight," herein used, No. 13—1.

shall mean "The Land Claims Settlement Act, 1856," and "The Land Claims Settlement Extension Act, 1858," respectively. The term "Commissioners" shall mean any Commissioner appointed under the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, and every such Commissioner shall be deemed to have the powers hereby vested in the Commissioners. The provisions of this Act shall be of force, anything in the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six and the rules established thereunder, or in the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, to the contrary notwithstanding.

Claims not prosecuted to lapse. and fifty-eight, to the contrary notwithstanding.

3. Any of the claims in the Schedule hereto which shall not be 10 prosecuted before the thirty-first day of December, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, shall be deemed to have lapsed, and the Commissioners shall adjudge such claims to have lapsed, and notice of such adjudication shall be published in the New Zealand Gazette: Provided always that the Commissioners may, in their discretion, in 15 any case, upon reasonable grounds being shown, extend such period, such extension not to exceed six months.

4. The land in any claim so adjudged to have lapsed shall be

5. Whenever any selection of land is required to be made under the provisions of the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, or the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, the Commis-

the provisions of the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, or the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, the Commissioners may prescribe a period within which such selection shall be made, and if the selection be not made within such period, such right 25 of selection shall lapse and be deemed abandoned, and the claimant or claimants shall have no further right, title, or interest in respect of such claim, or in respect of any land the subject of such claim.

6. In any claim in which difficulties exist in the way of obtaining quiet possession of the land to which the claimant is entitled, and in 30 which the survey of the claim cannot be made in a reasonable time, to be fixed by the Commissioners, the Commissioners shall determine the claim by directing a grant of other land in exchange, or by the issue of scrip, as provided in section three of the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight.

7. The forty-third section of the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof it is enacted as follows:—

In all cases of surveys and maps required by the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six the Commissioners may order 40 such surveys or maps to be made under their own direction.

8. The forty-fourth section of the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-six is hereby repealed.

9. And whereas the claimants in claims numbers sixty-four and one thousand one hundred and twenty-eight were unable, through circumstances over which they had no control, to prosecute their claims within the time prescribed by the Act of one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, and it is expedient that relief should be given in respect of the said claims:

Be it therefore further enacted that the Commissioners are hereby 50 empowered to investigate the said claims numbers sixty-four and one thousand one hundred and twenty-eight, and to make such orders and adjudication therein as they shall deem to be just.
