A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Provisions of "The Land for Settlements Consolidation Act, 1900." Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Land for Settlements Act Extension Act, 1905"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Land for Settlements Consolidation Act, 1900" Short Title.
10 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").

2. (1.) The maximum amount that may be raised under section thirty-two of the principal Act by the Colonial Treasurer in any financial year is hereby increased from five hundred thousand pounds to seven hundred and fifty thousand pounds. Maximum amount that may be raised.

15 (2.) The said section thirty-two is hereby consequentially amended by repealing the words "five hundred thousand" wherever they occur and substituting in lieu thereof the words "seven hundred and fifty thousand."
