## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to make provision for Extending and Securing the Liberty Title. of the Press.

WHEREAS it is desirable that some limitation should be placed upon Preamble. the power at present existing of proceeding criminally in respect of alleged libels:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Liberty of the Press Exten- Short Title. sion Act, 1881."

2. From and after the passing of this Act, no criminal proceedings Criminal proceedings 10 shall be instituted or taken in respect of any alleged libellous matter for libel not to be appearing in any newspaper, unless and until the consent of the sent of Attorney-Attorney-General for the time being shall have first been obtained.

3. In the event of a vacancy in the office of Attorney-General, Solicitor-General the Solicitor-General shall possess the powers of the Attorney-General may act if no Attorney-General. Attorney-General 15 for the purposes of this Act.

4. This Act shall not apply to any criminal proceedings for libel Saving of existing which may be on foot at the time of its coming into force.
