2. Principal Act to have no application to motor vehicles that are for the time being subject to regulations as to lighting made under the Motor-vehicles Act.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Lights on Vehicles Act, 1915.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Lights on Vehicles Amendment Act, 1925, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Lights on Vehicles Act, 1915 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title.

10 2. The principal Act shall have no application in respect of any motor-vehicles if and so long as they are subject to any regulations as to lighting made pursuant to the powers in that behalf conferred on the Governor-General by the Motor-vehicles Act, 1924.

Principal Act to have no application to motor-vehicles that are for the time being subject to regulations as to lighting made under the Motor-vehicles Act.
