A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Law Practitioners Act, 1882."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Law Practitioners Act 1882 Amendment Act, 1885." Short Title.

2. Subsection two of section six of "The Law Practitioners Act, 1882," is hereby repealed, and the following is enacted in lieu thereof, namely,— Subsection two of section six repealed, and another substituted.

10 (2.) Any person who has been admitted a solicitor of the Court, provided no rule or enactment shall be in force to the effect that practitioners shall not practice both as barristers and solicitors, and who has passed such additional examination in general knowledge and law as is hereinafter mentioned, if he applies for admission after the  
15 fifteenth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven.

20 And the said section six shall be read and construed as though such substituted provision had been inserted therein in lieu of the said subsection.
