ANALYSIS.

1. Short Title. | 2. Section 3 of Amendment Act, 1913, amended.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Law Practitioners Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Law Practitioners Amendment Act, 1915, and shall form part of and be read together with the Law Practitioners Act, 1908.

Short Title.

2. Section three of the Law Practitioners Amendment Act, 1913, is hereby amended as follows:—

Section 3 of Amendment Act, 1913, amended.

(a.) By omitting the words "ten shillings" in subsection one thereof, and substituting the words "one pound one shilling";

(b.) By omitting from subsection two the words "for the purposes of the said Society"; and

(c.) By adding the following subsection:—

"(3.) The Treasurer of the New Zealand Law Society shall, in respect of every such additional fee received by him, forthwith pay over to the New Zealand Council of Law Reporting the sum of eleven shillings."
