This Public Bill originated in the House of Representatives, and, having this day passed as now printed, is transmitted to the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL for its concurrence.

LAW PRACTITIONERS AMENDMENT.

ANALYSIS.

Title. 1. Short Title. 3. King's Counsel shall not practise as 2. Section 3 of Amendment Act, 1913, amended.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Law Practitioners Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Law Practitioners Amendment Short Title. Act, 1915, and shall form part of and be read together with the Law Practitioners Act, 1908.

2. Section three of the Law Practitioners Amendment Act, Section 3 of 1913, is hereby amended as follows:—

(a.) By omitting the words "ten shillings," in subsection one thereof, and substituting the words "one pound one shilling";

(b.) By omitting from subsection two the words "for the purposes of the said Society"; and

(c.) By adding the following subsection:— "(3.) The Treasurer of the New Zealand Law Society shall, in respect of every such additional fee received by him, forthwith pay over to the New Zealand Council of Law Reporting the sum of eleven shillings."

20 3. No practising barrister of the rank of King's Counsel shall King's Counsel also practise as a solicitor, either alone or in partnership with any shall not practise as a solicitor. other solicitor, and no certificate under section forty-five of the principal Act shall be issued to any such barrister; but this provision shall not apply to any barrister in New Zealand at present holding 25 the patent of King's Counsel.
