A BILL INTITULED

AN Act to prevent any Barrister or Solicitor from appearing in any Case in which his Father or other near Relation is to adjudicate as Judge. Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Lawyers Prohibition Act, 1890." Short Title.

10 2. No barrister or solicitor of the Supreme Court of New Zealand shall appear either in the Supreme Court or in the Resident Magistrate's Court in any case in which his father or other near relation is to adjudicate as Judge or Resident Magistrate. No barrister or solicitor to appear in certain cases.
