A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to enable Superintendents and Provincial Councils to allocate to Local Governing Bodies a portion of the Revenues arising within their respective Districts. Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient that Provincial Legislatures should be empowered to allocate or grant to local governing bodies certain revenues arising within the territorial limits of such governing bodies respectively : Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Local Revenues Allocation Act, 1872." Short Title.

2. The Superintendent and Provincial Council of every Province may, in and by an Act or Ordinance in that behalf passed, grant and allocate to any Municipality or County or other local governing body by law established and incorporated, to be included in and form part of the ordinary revenue of such governing body, all or any part of the revenues following, arising within the territorial limits of such governing body:— Provincial Councils empowered to allocate revenues to Municipalities and Counties.

- (1.) Fees and dues payable for licenses and registration under the provisions of any Provincial Act or Ordinance.
- (2.) Fees and dues payable for licenses by miners and persons carrying on business within any gold field, or for licenses by persons for the occupation of residence areas.
- (3.) Rents payable by licensees or lessees to the Receiver of Land Revenue under any Ordinance of the Provincial Legislature or Act of the General Assembly of New Zealand.
- (4.) Money paid for or arising from sales of the Waste Lands of the Crown.
