A BILL INTITULED

An Acr to amend the Local Railways Act, 1914.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Railways Amendment Short Title. Act, 1915, and shall form part of and be read together with the Local Railways Act, 1914 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section fifty of the principal Act is hereby amended by Section 50 of 10 inserting, after subsection four, the following subsection:-

principal Act amended.

"(4a.) An Order in Council under this section may authorize the construction of a railway extending beyond the limits of the district for such distance as may be necessary for the purpose of 15 effecting a connection with a Government railway."

3. Section fifty-six of the principal Act is hereby amended by Section 56 of inserting, in subsection one after the word "within," the words "or principal Act beyond the limits of."
