An Act to amend the Local Railways Act, 1914.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as

1. This Act may be cited as the Local Railways Amendment Short Title. Act, 1920, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Local Railways Act, 1914 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

10 2. Section two of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding Section 2 of thereto the following definition:—

"'Railway' includes an extension of a railway."

3. Section three of the principal Act is hereby amended by Section 3 of

adding thereto the following subsection:—

"(3.) On a like petition signed by not less than one-fourth of constitution of the ratepayers of any defined area adjoining a railway district, the railway districts) Governor-General may, by Proclamation, alter the boundaries of that district by the inclusion therein of that adjoining area. Any expenses incurred in connection with and preliminary to the constitution of 20 the district shall be assumed by the Board on its constitution."

4. (1.) The gauge of every railway to be constructed under the Gauge of railways principal Act shall be of such width as the Governor-General in under principal Council may determine.
