A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Lyttelton Waterworks Transfer Act, 1878."

Title.

WHEREAS by "The Lyttelton Waterworks Transfer Act, 1878,"

Preamble.

5 certain waterworks therein referred to were vested in the Corporation
of the Borough of Lyttelton, subject to certain conditions, rights,
powers, and privileges specified in the Second Schedule thereto, one
of which was that Her late Majesty Queen Victoria should on the
twenty-fourth day of October in each year pay to the said Corporation
the sum of one hundred pounds as a contribution towards the main-
10 tenance and working-expenses of the said waterworks: And whereas
the cost of maintenance and the working-expenses in connection
with the said waterworks have greatly increased since the year one
thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, and the said Corporation
has expended large sums of money in improving the said waterworks
15 and extending the supply therefrom, and the said annual payment
is not now a fair contribution towards the maintenance and working-
expenses of the said waterworks:

20 BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New
Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Lyttelton Waterworks Short Title.
Transfer Act 1878 Amendment Act, 1902."

25 2. After the passing of this Act "The Lyttelton Waterworks
Transfer Act, 1878" (hereinafter called "the said Act"), shall be read
as though the words "not less than two hundred pounds" had been
inserted in the thirty-fourth line of the Second Schedule to the said
Act in lieu of the words "one hundred pounds."
