A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Law relating to Marriage.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

5 1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Marriage Act 1880 Amendment Act, 1896 (No. 2)." It shall be deemed to be incorporated with "The Marriage Act, 1880" (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act").

Short Title.

10 2. The definition of "Officiating Minister" in the said Act shall be deemed to include any person nominated for the purpose of officiating at marriages under the said Act by twenty-four householders belonging to any religious congregation in which there is no officiating minister.
