A BILL INTITULED

AN Act to amend "The Mining Act, 1898." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as

5 follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Mining Act Amendment Act, 1902 (No. 2)." Short Title.

2. The words "exclusive of meal-times" in section five of "The Mining Act Amendment Act, 1901," are hereby repealed. Repeal.

10 3. The word "miner" where used in the said section five shall mean and include every workman employed underground in a mine. Interpretation of word "miner."
