A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Master and Apprentice Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the Master and Apprentice Amendment Act, 1924, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Master and Apprentice Act, 1908.

Short Title.

2. Section five of the Master and Apprentice Amendment Act, 1920, is hereby amended by omitting from subsection two the words “(if he has no parent or guardian),” and substituting the words “(if he has no parent or guardian in New Zealand).”

Minister of Lands may execute indentures of apprenticeship to occupation of farming for boys without parent or guardian in New Zealand.
