A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Mining Act, 1905."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

The Short Title of this Act is "The Mining Act Amendment Act, 1906"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Mining Act, 1905" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").</p> <p>2. Paragraph (45) of section two hundred and fifty-five is hereby amended by inserting after the word "Act" the words "and of every amendment thereof."</p> <p>3. Nothing in section one hundred and twenty-two of "The Public Works Act, 1905," shall authorise the removal of any metal or mineral under any land mentioned in that section except under the authority of a mining privilege.</p> <p>4. Subsection two of section one hundred and four of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding the following words: "Provided that in the case of the lease already granted under this section to the Public Trustee, as and being the executor and trustee of the will of the late Sir Alfred Jerome Cadman, bearing date the fifteenth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and five, the power of purchase shall not be exercised until after the expiration of twenty-eight years from the commencement of the term of the lease, and the lease shall be construed accordingly."</p> <p>5. Notwithstanding anything in the principal Act the Minister, on the recommendation of the Board of Examiners, may grant or refuse a certificate of competency to any person on any grounds he deems advisable.</p> <p>6.
