**A BILL INTITULED**

**An Act to amend the Municipal Association Act 1939**

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Municipal Association Amendment Act 1956, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Municipal Association Act 1939 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

**2. Allowance to President**—(1) Section seven of the principal Act (as amended by section twenty-two of the Statutes Amendment Act 1943) is hereby further amended by omitting from subsection two the words “two hundred pounds”, and substituting the words “four hundred pounds”.

(2) Section twenty-two of the Statutes Amendment Act 1943 is hereby repealed.
