# MILK AMENDMENT BILL

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Clause 1 relates to the Short Title.

Clause 2 restores to the New Zealand Milk Board 2 powers it lost as a consequence of the passage of the Milk Amendment Act 1980—the power to fix special allowances for the treatment and delivery of milk higher than the general allowances fixed under the Commerce Act 1975 (but before the passing of the Milk Amendment Act 1980 fixed by the Milk Prices Authority), and the power to fix those allowances and various other special allowances and special prices retrospectively.

The Board has at all times acted as if it continued to have those powers; and subclause (3) validates its actions in doing so, and the actions of all other persons

who have acted in reliance on the Board's actions.

### A BILL INTITULED

## An Act to amend the Milk Act 1967

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:

- 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Milk Amendment Act 1982, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Milk Act 1967\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 10 **2. Fixing prices and conditions of sale of milk**—(1) Section 25 (5) (a) of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "under this section", the words ", or (by virtue of subsection (3) of this section) fixed under the Commerce Act 1975".
- 15 (2) Section 25 (7) of the principal Act (as substituted by section 6 (2) of the Milk Amendment Act 1980) is hereby amended by omitting the words "or subsection (4)", and substituting the words ", subsection (4), or subsection (5)".
- (3) Every action by any person on or after the 16th day of 20 December 1980 is hereby deemed to have been as valid and effectual as if <u>subsections (1) and (2)</u> of this section had come into force on that day.
