## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to make an additional Endowment for the Title. Milton Athenæum.

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto has been Preamble. withdrawn from sale, and it is expedient to vest the same in the Trustees of the Milton Athenaum, incorporated under "The Milton Athenæum Reserve Act, 1876":

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Milton Athenæum Short Title Endowment Act, 1878."

2. On the passing of this Act the land described in the Schedule Lands vested in hereto shall, without any grant or conveyance, be vested in the Milton Athonsum for endowment. Trustees of the Milton Athenæum, incorporated under the provisions of "The Milton Athenaum Reserve Act, 1876," and shall be held by them for the purposes of the said Act.
