A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Municipal Corporations Act, Tible. 1876."

THEREAS it is expedient to amend in certain particulars "The Preamble. Municipal Corporations Act, 1876" (hereinafter called "the said Act"):

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 5 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Municipal Corpora- Short Title. tions Act 1876 Amendment Act, 1878."

2. Section three hundred and forty-two of the said Act is hereby copy by-law under 10 repealed and the following substituted in lieu thereof:—

A copy of any by-law, sealed with the common seal of the Corporation, shall be received as evidence of the same having been in force within any borough at the time of its becoming a borough under the said Act, and of the same having been duly made as by law 15 provided in that behalf, unless in either case the contrary is proved; and a copy of any by-law sealed with the seal of the Corporation shall be received as evidence of any by-law made since the said Act came into force, and that the same was duly made as by the said Act provided, unless the contrary is proved.
