A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to further amend "The Municipal Corporations Act, Title, 1886."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in
5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Municipal Corporations Act 1886 Amendment Act, 1890 (No. 2)," and it shall be read with
and as part of the said Act. Short Title.

2. The Council may from time to time make, alter, or repeal
10 by-laws for regulating the times when, and the conditions on which, traction-engines may be allowed to pass along any street or road within the borough, and to impose penalties for the breach of such by-laws. By-laws *re* traction-engines.
