A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1886." Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the provisions of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1886," in so far as they relate to the control of 5 boundary roads should be amended : Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Municipal Corporations 10 Act 1886 Amendment Act, 1897." Short Title.

2. From and after the passing of this Act section two hundred and thirty-nine of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1886," is amended by the insertion of the words "or road district" after the words "town district" wheresoever the latter words occur in 15 the said section. Control of boundary roads.
