A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1886."

Title.

WHEREAS it is expedient to empower the Borough Council of Sydenham to erect gasworks for the purpose of supplying the Borough of Sydenham with gas :

Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Municipal Corporations Act 1886 Amendment Act, 1887."

Short Title.

2. This Act shall be read subject to the interpretations respectively contained in "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1886" (hereinafter called "the said Act").

Interpretation.

3. The provisions of section number three hundred and sixty-nine of the said Act, after the word "Act" in the fourth line of the said section, shall not apply to the locality comprised within the boundaries of the Borough of Sydenham and the boundary-roads thereof, and the Council of the said borough shall within such locality, notwithstanding the provisions of the said section and "The Christchurch Gas Act, 1870," have and may exercise all or any of the powers, rights, and privileges vested by the said Act in the Council of a borough for which gasworks for the supply of gas have not been established under the authority of an Act of the General Assembly.

Part of section 369 of "Municipal Corporations Act, 1886," not to apply to Borough of Sydenham.
