### A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Mining Companies Act, 1886."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Mining Companies Act 1886 Amendment Act, 1888." Short Title.

2. The power given by "The Mining Companies Act, 1886," to the creditors of a company to appoint some fit person to be liquidator of the estate of the company, and to determine the remuneration of and fix the security to be given by the said liquidator shall not hereafter be exercised by the creditors, but the making of any such appointment of liquidator, the determining the remuneration of, and fixing the security to be given by, the said liquidator shall be made by the Court in which the winding-up proceedings are being carried on, and all provisions of "The Mining Companies Act, 1886," contrary to or in conflict with this section shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
