- 1 Title**
This Act is the Maori Commercial Aquaculture Claims Settlement Amendment Act **2006**.
- 2 Commencement**
This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent. 5
- 26 Principal Act amended**
This Part amends the Maori Commercial Aquaculture Claims Settlement Act 2004. 10
- 27 Interpretation**
- (1) Paragraphs (c) and (d)(i) and (ii) of the definition of **pre-commencement space** in section 20 are amended by omitting “67Q” and substituting in each case “67Q(2)(a)”.
- (2) Paragraph (d)(i) of the definition of **pre-commencement space** in section 20 is amended by adding “, and the permit that was granted is for aquaculture activities”. 15
