A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to validate the Appointment of Michael Connelly, Esquire, to be a Member of the Legislative Council. Title.

WHEREAS by an instrument of appointment dated the ninth day of March, nineteen hundred and thirty-six, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, purporting to act under the authority of the Legislature Act, 1908, did summon Michael Connelly, Esquire, of Dunedin, to the Legislative Council, to be a member thereof: And whereas on the said date the said Michael Connelly was disqualified from being so summoned, inasmuch as he was then a Civil servant within the meaning of section two of the Legislature Act, 1908: And whereas it is desired to validate the said appointment: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Michael Connelly Appointment Validation Act, 1936. Short Title.

The appointment of Michael Connelly, Esquire, to be a member of the Legislative Council of New Zealand, as hereinbefore recited, is hereby validated, and the said Michael Connelly shall accordingly be deemed to have been duly summoned to the Legislative Council, to be a member thereof, on the ninth day of March, nineteen hundred and thirty-six. 5

Private Act.

3. This Act is hereby declared to be a private Act.
