A BILL INTITULED

Act to sever the Moa Road District from the Taranaki Title. County, and to constitute, in Substitution for the said Road District, a County to be called the "Moa County."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Moa County Act, 1915.

2. The Moa County is hereby constituted, and shall comprise Constitution of Moa 10 all that area the boundaries whereof are particularly described in County. the First Schedule hereto, being that portion of the Taranaki County known as the Moa Road District.

3. The said Moa Road District is hereby abolished, and shall be Moa Road District deemed to be merged in the said Moa County; and the provisions of abolished. 15 section thirty-six of the Counties Act, 1908, shall apply accordingly.

4. The boundaries of the said Taranaki County are hereby Taranaki County

altered as described in the Second Schedule hereto.

5. From and after the coming into operation of this Act no local Jurisdiction of Mosa authority other than the Council of the Moa County shall, within the &c. 20 limits of the said county, exercise any jurisdiction or authority whatsoever over any roads or over or in relation to any matter or thing whatsoever in respect of which jurisdiction is conferred upon County Councils under any Act:

Provided that nothing herein shall affect the power of the 25 Governor to proclaim any portion of the said county a borough, town,

SCHEDULES.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Boundaries of Proposed Moa County.

ALL that area of land in the Taranaki Land District, excluding the Borough of Inglewood, bounded towards the east and south and south-east by the northern boundary of the Stratford County from the confluence of the Makino Stream and the Waitara River to the summit of Mount Egmont; thence generally towards the west by a straight line to the source of the Waiwakaiho River and by a line along the middle of the said Waiwakaiho River to a point in a line with the southern boundary of Section 48, Block X, Paritutu Survey District; thence towards the north generally by a straight line to the south-western corner and by the southern and eastern boundaries of said Section 48 to the south-west corner of Section 44, Block X, Paritutu Survey District; thence by the southern boundary of the said Section 44 to the west side of the Egmont Road; thence following the said western side of the Egmont Road to a point in line with the northern boundary of Section 46, Block X, Paritutu Survey District; thence crossing the Egmont Road to the northwest corner of Section 46, Block X, Paritutu Survey District; thence following in an easterly direction the northern boundaries of Sections 46 and 28, Block X, Paritutu Survey District, to the Upland Road; thence crossing the Upland Road to the north-west corner of Section 33, Block XI, Paritutu Survey District: thence following the northern and part of the eastern boundaries of said Section 33 to the north-east corner of Section 42, Block XI, Paritutu Survey District; thence by the northern boundary of the said section to the King Road; thence by the western side of the King Road to a point in line with the southern boundary of Section 80, Block XI, Paritutu Survey District; thence crossing the King Road to the south-west corner and along the southernmost boundary of the said Section 80 to the Hursthouse Road; thence along the south-west side of the Hursthouse Road to a point in line with the southern boundary of Section 55, Block XI, Paritutu Survey District; thence crossing the Hursthouse Road to the south-western corner and along the southern boundary of said Section 55 to the western boundary of Section 203, Block XI, Paritutu Survey District; thence along the said western boundary to the south-west corner of said Section 203; thence along the south-eastern boundary of said Section 203 to the Waiongona Stream; thence along the middle of the Waiongona Stream to a point in line with the southern boundary of Section 127, Block XI, Paritutu Survey District; thence crossing the Waiongona Stream to the south-west corner and along the southernmost boundary of the said Section 127 to the Wortley Road; thence following the western side of the Wortley Road to a point in line with the southernmost boundary of Section 115, Block XI, Paritutu Survey District; thence crossing the Wortley Road to the south-west corner and along the southernmost boundary of the said Section 115 and southerly along the western boundaries of Sections 116 and 206, Block XIII. Waitara Survey District, to the south-west corner of the said Section 206; thence easterly along the southern boundary of said Section 206 and the same line continued to the eastern side of the Richmond Road; thence along the eastern side of the Richmond Road to the southern boundary of Section 207, Block XIII, Waitara Survey District; thence easterly along the southern boundary and northerly along the eastern boundary of said Section 207 and of part Section 133, Block XIII, Waitara Survey District, to the north-west corner of Section 1, Block XIII, Waitara Survey District; thence following the northernmost boundary of the said Section 1 to the western boundary of Section 208, Block XIII, Waitara Survey District: thence south-westerly along the western boundaries of Sections 208 and 209. Block XIII, Waitara Survey District, to the south-west corner of said Section 200; thence along the southernmost boundary of said Section 209 to the York Road and by a continuation of the last-mentioned straight line across the York Road to the western boundary of Section 211, Block XIII, Waitara Survey District: thence southerly along the said western boundary of Section 211 and easterly along the southern boundary of the same section to its south-east corner; thence north-westerly along the eastern boundary of said Section 211 and of Sections 166 and 210, Block XIII, Waitara Survey District, to the southern boundary of Section 167, Block XIII, Waitara Survey District, and north-easterly along the said southern

boundary of Section 167 and the southern boundary of Section 169, Block XIII. Waitara Survey District, to the western side of the Everett Road; thence by a line along the middle of the Mangapotoa Stream to the Manganui Stream; thence by a line along the middle of the Manganui Stream to its confluence with the Waitara River: thence bounded generally towards the north-east by the south-western boundary of the Clifton County to the northern boundary of the Stratford County, the point of commencement.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

AMENDED BOUNDARIES OF THE TARANAKI COUNTY.

ALL that area of land in the Taranaki Land District, excluding the Borough of New Plymouth, bounded towards the south-west by the Egmont County, towards the north-west by the Tasman Sea, towards the north-east by the Borough of Waitara and the Clifton County to the confluence of the Waitara River and the Manganui Stream, and towards the south-east by the north-western boundary of the Moa County as hereinbefore described.
